Oak Ridges Hospice first opened our doors in April 2021, celebrating two years open to our community in 2023 Currently, we are the only residential Hospice in Durham Region. Since opening, we have had over 250 residents and their families through our doors.

What do we do?

Oak Ridges Hospice has a specialized care team, comprised of nurses, PSW's, our clinical lead, Director of Care, and Medical Director to provide compassionate and the best end of life care for a resident.

Oak Ridges Hospice allows family to be family again. Often times, family members assume the role of care giver and are unaware of the supports available.

Oak Ridges assists residents and their families to navigate the health care system, link community supports, provides Spiritual & Care Giver supports, and provide so many more options to residents and their families.

Funding Oak Ridges Hospice

Oak Ridges Hospice is funded only 47% by the Ministry of Health, the other 53% comes from donations, grants, and third party event fundraisers. We are so fortunate to receive support from events such as Amazing Race, Port Perry and Hike for Hospice.
