1.0 Issue / Origin

The 2023 tournament was a success with sold out registration of 132 golfers. After the details of this report have been discussed with the Golf Committee this report will bring this year's details to Council.

2.0 Background

The Annual Charity Golf Tournament has supported youth programs in our community since 1999. The tournament has been supported by local business and individuals, making it the success it has been. To date the tournament has raised almost \$250,000.00 for the youth in Brock.

3.0 Analysis

In 2023, the golf tournament raised \$13,470.85, which is detailed in the financial report below. We registered 132 golfers to fill our day. We had four GOLD level sponsors each contributing \$2,500.00, one BRONZE level sponsor contributing \$1,000, a full compliment of 18-hole sponsors contributing \$250.00 each plus our lunch and snack sponsors and some great prize donations. All from businesses and golf enthusiasts with invested interest in supporting Brock Township's youth.

For the remainder of 2023, the Golf Committee will focus on receiving new applications from groups for new projects in the Township of Brock. Staff will continue to work through previously committed grant applicants from the previous four years to determine project completion, extension requests due to COVID-19 or cancellation of the programs and associated grants.
