# What is Intimate Partner Violence

• Intimate Partner Violence (IPV) refers to behaviour by an intimate partner or expartner that causes physical, sexual, or psychological harm including physical aggression, sexual coercion, psychological abuse, and controlling behaviours.

## **Key Facts**

Violence against women is a major public health problem

Every six days a woman in Canada is killed by her intimate partner

One in five women experience some form of abuse in their intimate relationship

This past year alone, 52 women in Ontario, or one every week were victims of femicide.

2 women have been killed by men in Renfrew County since December of 20-22



### November 2022 – July 2023 4 Femicides in Durham Region

Nov. 12 – 8-yearold girl was killed by her father
