- Registered charity since 2004
- Servicing North Durham townships of Brock, Uxbridge, and Scugog
- We assist people in our community who are homeless or are at risk of becoming homeless
- Our top strategic objective: Lead the housing supports agenda in north Durham







Some Statistics for 2022 in Brock

- 81 households that accessed services at North House
- Out of those 81 households, 33 were brand new to North House in 2022
- Those 81 households represent 128 individuals
- There are 20 individuals from Brock who are chronically homeless and are engaged with North House through our housing first program

Affordable Housing

- Every resident of Brock deserves a safe and affordable place to call home
- COVID-19 and the rising costs of goods and housing are increasing the number of individuals who cannot afford to live in our community
- Discrimination still exists for those facing homelessness
- Together we need to look at short and long term options to create more housing options

Affordable Housing - Options

- Shelter
- Transitional Housing
- Permanent Housing
 - Community Land Trust
 - Tiny Homes
 - Designated number of affordable units for new builds

- Will Council consider repurposing town owned properties to create a shelter for those who have no place to live?
