Parade: The parade will start at the Beaverton Fairgrounds on Main St. flow through to Bay St., north on Osborne St., and west on Simcoe St., and back to the Beaverton Fairgrounds. **We ask that the Township please provide the barriers for road closures.** For further information regarding the parade please contact **Chuck Gillespie** [REDACTED]

Finally, the club will require use of the fairgrounds for fireworks through Victory Fireworks. The evening events will start at 7 pm with live entertainment and will close out with fireworks at dusk.
