1. Call to Order - Faye opened the meeting at 1 pm

### 2. Confirmation of Minutes

Moved by Annette, Seconded by Dorothy that the minutes of the November 18<sup>th</sup> meeting approved as revised. MOTION CARRIED.

## 3. Treasurer's Report

Annette handed out a bank statement showing a bank balance of \$782.37 as of November 21, 2024. The profit from Cash on the Barrelhead music night was \$298.25. Moved by Edie, Seconded by Keith that the bank statements be accepted as read. MOTION CARRIED.

#### 4. General Items

- Public Meeting will be at the township office on December 18<sup>th</sup>. Faye reviewed the 3 meetings we'd already held on the topic: 1) Oct 8<sup>th</sup> met with township staff; 2) Oct 31<sup>st</sup> members met and passed a motion to keep hall open with this wording: "We, the hall board in Wilfrid, don't want Wilfrid Hall to close. The hall was meant to serve this part of the township. Therefore we have no recommendation of how the township should use the reserve of approximately \$9,648.50"; and 3) November 18<sup>th</sup> members met to discuss the Public Meeting on selling Wilfrid Hall.
- We discussed who should attend the Public Meeting. It was agreed that all members should to attend. Various members planned their topics to present to Council.
- Faye will contact Fernando to find out the format of the Public Meeting and talk to Cria to see whether an extension is possible. Fernando passed on information to Faye: only those persons who needed a virtual link need to register with the township clerk.
- Plans were made for the Kid's Christmas Party on Sunday, Dec 15<sup>th</sup> from 1 3 pm. Guests are Santa Claus, Chanel (Early On program) and The Grinch. Set up is Saturday, Dec 14<sup>th</sup> at 10 am. Games to play were discussed. Refreshments: Dorothy and Faye will each make 3 dozen gingerbread cookies to eat. We'll serve hot

- chocolate and make Goodie Bags for kids to take home. Moved by Annette, Seconded by Dorothy that the budget now be \$200 for the Kid's Christmas Party. MOTION CARRIED.
- Barb offered that our members take a Food Handling Course that she has set up. She
  will give us booklets and after we take the test we will get a certificate that lasts for 5
  years.
