Be It Resolved That Council delegates authority to the Director of Public Works to initiate actions for the immediate removal of excess snow throughout critical areas in the Township of Brock, in order to permit the safe entrance and egress of emergency vehicles and so that any additional snowfalls may be efficiently managed by Township staff for regular clearing activities which will ensure that the community is safe; and

That Council authorize the Director of Public Works to utilize any number of options including Township staff, Regional Works staff, and/or outside contractors, to assist with the snow clearing activities; and

That Council authorize the Director of Public Works to sole source under the Township's Procurement By-law with the use of third party contractors used for excess snow removal; and

That Council authorize the Director of Public Works to spend reasonable and needed funds from the Winter Control Reserve to achieve the removal of excess snow; and

That Council directs that staff keep Council updated as to total funds expended should the related expenditures exceed \$50,000, with regular updates to take place by emails and Council meetings whichever is more timely.
