

Good afternoon,

I am reaching out with this formal request to inquire about a rent rate reduction for Manilla Community Hall on Thursday evenings 7pm for 1.5 hours. The hall will be used by Narcotics Anonymous (NA) which is a not-for-profit 12 step program. We are hoping to have the rent geared to donations received during our 7<sup>th</sup> tradition practice during each meeting and as our meeting membership grows our donation to the hall will grow too.

The closest meetings for Brock are Lindsay, Orillia, Newmarket, or Oshawa/Whitby. The option of a local meeting will support many in the surrounding area and offer a solution for people in need.

Typically, meetings can arrange from 4-30 people with donations \$1-\$20 per meeting depending on people's income.

The meeting would be weekly, 52 weeks of the year, on-going on an annual basis.

We request 50 dollars a month for the first 6 months. That way we can see what the attendance is, then we can re-evaluate after that.
