

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BROCK

BY-LAW NUMBER 3337-2025

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE USE OF ALTERNATIVE VOTING METHODS FOR THE 2026 MUNICIPAL AND SCHOOL BOARD ELECTIONS

WHEREAS Sections 42(1)(a) and (b) of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, SO 1996, c 32 provides that the Council of a Municipality may, by by-law, authorize the use of vote-counting equipment such as optical scan vote tabulators and the use of alternative voting methods that do not require electors to attend a voting place in order to vote;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Brock deems it desirable to utilize such methods and alternatives during the 2026 Municipal & School Board Elections which will take place on Monday, October 26, 2026;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Brock enacts as follows:

1. THAT the alternative voting methods of “Internet Voting” and “Ballot-On-Demand” are hereby authorized for the Municipal & School Board Elections to be held in 2026; and
2. THAT the Council hereby authorizes the use of optical scanning vote tabulators for the purpose of counting the paper ballots received.
