THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BROCK

BY-LAW NUMBER 3351-2025

BEING A BY-LAW TO REQUIRE A BY-ELECTION FOR THE OFFICE OF MAYOR AND TO AUTHORIZE THE USE OF ALTERNATIVE VOTING METHODS.

WHEREAS Section 284.12 of the Municipal Act, 1996, 2001, provides that if a vacancy occurs in the office of the head of council, the municipality shall require a by-election to be held, in accordance with the Municipal Elections Act, 1996;

AND WHEREAS Sections 42(1)(a) and (b) of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, SO 1996, c 32 provides that the Council of a Municipality may, by by-law, authorize the use of alternative voting methods;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Brock passed By-law # 3337-2025, on April 14, 2025, being a By-law to utilize the alternatives voting methods of "Internet Voting" "Telephone Voting" and "Ballot-On-Demand" are hereby authorized for the Municipal & School Board Elections to be held in 2026;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Brock enacts as follows:

- THAT Council hereby direct the Clerk to conduct a by-election to fill the vacant Office of Mayor; and
- 2. THAT the alternative voting methods of "Internet Voting" "Telephone Voting" and "Ballot-On-Demand" with use of optical scanning vote tabulators, authorized for use in the 2026 Municipal & School Board Elections by By-Law # 337-2025, hereby be authorized for use in the by-election.
