Hi there,

May I please make a formal request to include on the next available agenda for council to include erecting a few SLOW/Speed signs and wildlife and farming signs on Concession 14, Cannington.

I have lived on this road my entire life (40+ years) and have never experienced vehicle traffic and speeding as it is now.

In speaking with others on this concession road, we believe this is due to it being the closest paved sideroad off Highway 12 before/after Highway 48 and the light creating a convenient "detour" to Simcoe Street-and vice versa. This has created an influx of vehicles reaching speeds of well over 100 km/h on this road which is an actively farmed road of families with children-including a family with a child with a severe disability. Children are riding bikes, families are walking, cattle and other farm animals residing roadside, along with housing seasonally and yearlong wildlife such as bear, fox, coyote, opossum, deer, moose and many other wildlife. This is a lively sideroad.

The dangers of not having enforcement signs is high and puts many lives at risk.

Please seriously take into consideration erecting these signs along our road.
