**Subject:** Peace Street - Speed Control

Morning,

Hope this email reaches you well. We are reaching out to the council with the hopes of obtaining some resolution about the speed of drivers on Peace Street, in Cannington.

This has been a large concern of ours, and a considerable safety issue for some time now. Daily there are cars that are travelling up and down the street and erratic speeds that have put us in several dangerous situations.

Tuesday night was the breaking point for us. We were taking our dogs out for a walk, crossing our street to get to the sidewalk, as we stepped into the street a black VW came screaming off of Cameron, onto Peace. Ignoring the two children that were on bicycles, dropping a gear, and revving highly.

We yelled from the sidewalk, and motioned for the car to slow down, clearly showing frustration for the behaviour. The driver stopped in the middle of the road, where my partner approached the driver's window, and was immediately engaged in a heated exchange. The driver whined and complained that he was, in fact, not revving his car but that his exhaust simply made the noise.

Additionally, one of the councillors, who lives close-by, was a witness to the entire ordeal. They spoke with us after, and expressed their concern about the traffic and the erratic way in which people drive along the road.

Some of the neighbour's driveways on our street are recessed and it takes a while to check if the road is clear (ours included). At times, when leaving the driveway, we've had to stop abruptly because there is a car coming off of Cameron far too quickly, and down the centre of the street..

Watching people speed to and from the arena/community complex has become exhausting. Every evening while sitting in our living room, it is a constant soundtrack as people speed by. Especially in the summer months for baseball and the winter months for hockey,

We love living in Cannington, but this has definitely gotten out of hand.
