I am writing to you to express my concerns regarding the speed at which both parents and a few buses are driving at on Albert Street during drop off and pick up times at McCaskill's Mills PS. The speed bumps do not seem to be a deterrent. In the past few weeks I have twice witnessed our crossing guard Wendy almost be hit while ushering children across the road at Park and Albert. Furthermore, the situation is worse at Albert and Munro where there is only a two way stop sign with the high school pickup spot as well as many elementary children attempting to cross with no assistance. I believe that the intersection at Munro and Albert should be made a four way stop. This will promote a safe crossing zone for students and families going to both school and the bus pick up location. It would also help keep speeds down as drivers would no longer have from Cameron Street to the school without a stop. The speed coupled with the sheer number of young children walking is a recipe for an event that would devastate us all.

Please direct me to the proper channels to file a proper complaint and consideration for a proposed alteration of a 4way stop from the current 2way stop at Munro St W and Albert Street in Cannington.
