Subject: Cannington - Free Gazebo for Skateboard Park

Dear Mayor Jubb,

I am writing you on behalf of Civic Grid, the energy start-up company that is currently constructing a battery enclosure at the Nourish and Develop foundation in Cannington.

At the site, a large timber-frame gazebo has been salvaged and could be easily repurposed elsewhere in Cannington. Rather than throwing it away, we would like offer it for free to the township for its use.

We would like to propose that it be relocated to the local skatepark, where it can be permanently installed as a shade canopy. We noticed that the park does not have such a structure, and it would no doubt be a useful amenity for summer users.

David Slabodkin, a long time supporter of the foundation, has offered to pay for the installation of the gazebo at the skatepark, including moving it to site, and the installation of concrete footings to make it structurally sound. In return he has asked for a tax receipt for the costs associated with these works.

We have attached photos of the gazebo for your review. Please let us know if you are happy to proceed with this plan. We are happy to coordinate all intermediary steps including the application for necessary permits.

We have agreed arrangements for the storage of the Gazebo until November 15, so we kindly ask for your response before then.
