

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BROCK

BY-LAW NUMBER 3405-2026

BEING A BY-LAW TO APPOINT A COMPLIANCE AUDIT COMMITTEE PURSUANT TO THE MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS ACT, S.O. 1996, AS AMENDED

WHEREAS Section 88.37(1) of the *Municipal Elections Act*, S. O. 1996, as amended, provides that a municipal council shall establish a Compliance Audit Committee; and

WHEREAS the purpose of such committee is to address applications requesting an audit of a candidate, registered third party advertiser, or contributor to an election campaign and to consider reports from the Clerk citing apparent instances of over-contribution to municipal campaigns.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Brock hereby enacts as follows:

1. THAT Heather Allison, Mario Longo and Danielle Knight be appointed to the Township of Brock 2026-2030 Municipal Election Compliance Audit Committee; and
2. THAT Richard Hayden be appointed as an alternate member of the Township of Brock 2026-2030 Municipal Election Compliance Audit Committee; and
3. THAT the term of the Compliance Audit Committee shall be from November 15, 2026 until November 14, 2030; and
4. THAT the remuneration paid to each member of the Committee shall be as follows:
 - a) a \$400.00 retainer fee, which shall be split equally between the Townships of Brock, Scugog, and Uxbridge;
 - b) in the event of an application submitted for an audit of a Township of Brock candidates, third party advertisers, or contributors campaign finances or donations, \$150.00 for each meeting, which shall be paid by the Township of Brock; and,
 - c) mileage, at the present rate, or as adjusted from time to time by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Brock.
