DRUG ENFORCEMENT PROJECTS



Projects AMBASSADOR and HELLCAT

Throughout summer and fall of 2020 and early 2021, members and DRPS investigators observed an increase in drug activity and overdose related incidents in adults as young as 18 years. In addition, members of several small communities in the policing area made formal complaints surrounding the increase of drug trafficking and usage.

Hand-and-hand with substance dependency, investigators noted an increase in property crime, thefts and break and enters within the North Durham area.

In response to this, DRPS North Division members initiated project AMBASSADOR and HELLCAT. The objective of these projects were simple, locating and seizing illegal substances throughout all levels of trafficking and holding the accused persons to strict criminal release conditions.

DRUG ENFORCEMENT PROJECTS

Project AMBASSADOR results:

- 8 search warrants executed
- 17 individuals charged with over 55 charges laid
- The seizure of 275 grams of fentanyl, 920 grams of cocaine, 160 tabs of hydro morphine pills, crystal meth, GHB and approximately 17 pounds of cannabis; a total street value of over \$213,000
- \$12,000 in Canadian currency
- The seizure of a sawed off shotgun and ammunition

Project HELLCAT results:

- 6 search warrants executed
- 12 individuals charged with over 33 charges laid
- The seizure of 13.5 grams of fentanyl, 83 tabs of various prescriptions, 51.6 grams of cocaine and 11 grams of crystal meth; a total street value of over \$12,000
- \$4,550 in Canadian currency
- The seizure of a .22 caliber handgun and ammunition
- The seizure of 4 replica handguns

Project MOSQUITO

Project MOSQUITO is an annual fall drug sweep addressing illicit production and trafficking of cannabis throughout the Region.

2021 Results:

- 9 search warrants executed
- 10 grow ops dismantled; 7 of which, located in North Division.
- 22 individuals charged with over 41 charges laid
- The seizure of 11,008 cannabis plants, 774,755 grams of cannabis, and 439 grams of hashish oil; a total street value of \$20,965,930.
