The Nourish and Develop Foundation (TNDF) is seeking approval from Council to operate our Mobile Food Market (MFM) at Sunderland Arena, Alexander Muir Park, and Wilfird and Manilla Halls.

MFM is currently approved to operate outdoors at the following locations:

- Sunderland Fairgrounds
- Manilla Hall
- Wilfrid Hall
- Ed Perry Memorial Soccer Fields (Port Bolster)
- Gamebridge Park (next to the Women's Institute Hall)

As our MFM aims to be a reliable, consistent, accessible and affordable source of local produce year-around, securing indoor locations for our MFM to operate from is paramount. For that reason we are seeking approval to operate indoors from approximately November-April at:

- Sunderland Arena
- Wilfrid Hall
- Manilla Hall

And for the 'outdoor season' (April-November), to operate outdoors at Alexander Muir Park (adjacent to Beaverton Library).

We are looking to be at each location every 2 weeks for 1 hour between the hours of 11AM-6PM. We are currently operating every Wednesday and Thursday. We have some flexibility with days/times and can work around what's best for the Halls/arena.





We are seeking clarification on:

- a) Whether this is possible
- b) If permitted, what COVID-related rules apply e.g. vaccine passports, screening, etc.

TNDF is operating with approval from Durham Health, which includes approval of our COVID-19 policies and procedures for this market. We are happy to make accommodations to include those policies and procedures required by the Township.

As with the outdoor operations, we are happy to provide our proof of insurance (which covers a \$5,000,000 liability).

Ideally, we would like to use these Halls at no cost, but if there is a fee required, TNDF can likely make those arrangements.
