### 1.0 Issue / Origin

A Draft Plan of subdivision does not permanently name streets (placeholders like Street A are used). During the detailed design phase of the project, the permanent street names are assigned.

### 2.0 Background


In 2018, the Beaverton Lake Homes project began. In December 2020, draft plan approval was provided for the subdivision. The developer is now in the final design stages of the planning process of the project and has requested formal approval of street names.

### 3.0 Analysis

Brock does not currently have a formalize policy or process in place for naming streets. We have an approved list of names vetted by the Region of Durham that was provided to the developer to select from. The selected names are as follows and shown in Figure 1.

- Gordon Drive
- Parliament Court
- Basil McRae Crescent
- Dobson Drive
- Miller Drive
