TNDF is working to host a community clean-up in collaboration with the environmental organization <u>A</u> <u>Greener Future</u>. This event will run Saturday May 28th 10am-12pm. The event is open to anyone to attend. TNDF will be doing all registering online prior to that date.

Our plan is to have volunteers park at the Beaverton-Thorah Community Centre and then split into two groups. **Group A** will go towards Beaverton-Thorah Community Centre and pick up in the park and along the river, and **Group B** will go towards Beaverton Harbour & Harbour Park and focus on the shore of the Lake. Both groups will then work their way back to the arena to allow *A Greener Future* to gather data on what was collected for their stats purposes.

A Greener Future will provide equipment such as gloves, pickers, buckets, trash bags and take care of recycling cigarette butts, textiles, bottles, and cans.

What we would be looking to the Township to supply would be an extra receptacle for the non-recyclable garbage collected, or possibly, a special pick up, should we collect more than can fit into the receptacle.
