

Good morning, Council,

I am writing this letter to you regarding the Cannington Town Sign located at Hwy 12 & Regional Rd 12 in the south-east field. It has been brought to my attention that the sign is in need of replacement and possibly updated. I believe we created the sign back in June 2002. If my memory serves me correctly, the Township ran a small draw on the design of the current sign. **Local** residents submitted designs over a one-month period to the Township Building, Council then voted on which design they felt represented our town best. The chosen design was then sent to me for production. If you are interested in this same style event, I would gladly help with providing the requirements for the sign entries. Designs can be brought to my store so that I can make sure all requirements are met. At the end of the draw period, I would happily provide a printed copy of all the entries to Council to be voted upon. Please let me know if you would like to move forward with this proposal.

We would then remove the old signs and replace with the new ones, taking the old signs with us for recycling.
