Council Members I would like to bring your attention to the parking hazards that I view exist on James St in Sunderland.

On any given day you cannot drive down our street without at least 1 or more vehicles parked on the street, now don't get me wrong I know that this is sometimes unavoidable, however when those vehicles are parked on both sides of the street restricting the flow of traffic, this is where I have my concerns.

One of the residents on this street drives a work truck and when he tries to turn onto James St, coming home from work, he is unable to because of these vehicles being parked on both sides and sometimes so close to the corner it is impossible to get his vehicle thru, so he has to go down to the stop lights and come in from Doble Street. We should not have to go around the block to get to our own homes because of this parking issue.

I have lived here for 28 years and never complained, but this is starting to really bother me now that we are getting older and starting to have health issues. I believe that having these vehicles parked on both sides is really going to hinder the response time for our emergency vehicles if the situation ever arises.

I am proposing that there be no parking this side signs put on one side of the street and a no parking from here to corner sign so that we can get around the corner.

Another suggestion was brought forth to make James St a One Way street and still have the no parking this side signs on one side. The one way should be opposite to the One Way that is currently on Albert St.

We hope that you can help make our Street safer and more accessible for all. We look forward to your response to this issue.
