**Re:** Noise By-Law Exemption  
Beaverton Lake Homes (I/II)  
PART SOUTH 1/2 LOTS 14 & 15, CONCESSION ROAD 5

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We are the Engineering Consulting firm for the above mentioned Subdivision. We would like to request an exemption to the noise by-law (exemption 4 and in reference to Schedule 2 Item 10) in order to facilitate 24 hour pumping of the storm water pond.

The sound source will be specific to the running of the pumps for 24 hours a day during intermittent periods. The pumps will be operated by a "Centrifugal Environmental Silent Pump" placed as far away as possible to any resident.

The 24-hr use of the pumps are only to be run during intermittent periods (1-2 week maximum) to facilitate specific stages of construction. These specific stages would be limited to drawing the storm water pond down during storm sewer works in the storm block, storm pond clay lining works and/or after large rainfall events. Any other pumping or equipment use beyond these specific events will only be used during the allowable times set out within the noise by-law.

The running of the pumps will only be necessary up until the completion of the ultimate storm sewer outlet along Concession Road 5, which is expected to be completed by the end of September 2022.
