Good morning,

The safety of our students at Beaverton PS is paramount and I have a request for the council to consider in light of this safety.

There is an unfinished sidewalk in front of the school that was not completed by the municipality in lieu of the new school being built next year. Students heading west on King St. do not have a continuous sidewalk to follow which creates a safety hazard. Cars park directly on the road side and students are forced to walk around them. We are requesting that a sidewalk be installed and connect to the one in front of the school.

In addition, with a population of 340 students forecast for the 2022-2023 school year, any signage for parking would be appreciated. Drivers often park on the sidewalks as there is no curb, and in front of the fire hydrant. A well constructed sidewalk that students can walk down unimpeded is our goal.
