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#### 1.0 Issue / Origin

A Draft Plan of subdivision does not permanently name streets (placeholders like Street A are used). During the detailed design phase of the project, the permanent street names are assigned.

#### 2.0 Background

In 2018, the Beaverton Lake Homes project began. In December 2020, draft plan approval was provided for the subdivision. The developer is now in the final design stages of the planning process of the project and has requested formal approval of street names.

On December 13, 2021 a recommendation report was presented to Council, but not approved. This report contains revised geographically appropriate names vetted by the Region of Durham.

#### 3.0 Analysis

In the absence of a formalized Street Naming Policy, staff provided a list of geographically appropriate street names to the Region of Durham for approval to the formal Street Names list. It is important to

note that street types are assigned based on the preference of the municipality. The names formally added to the approved list are:

- Shale
- Bedrock
- Dogwood
- Lakeside
- Hilltop
- South Pond
- Northgate
- Western
- Bass
- Whitefish
- Trout
