Subject: Beaverton Harbour Advisory Committee (BHAC) – Sculpture Recommendation

On May 10, 2021 Committee adopted Resolution Number 23-6 “That the Committee receive communication 644 for information; and That the Committee defer this communication to June 14, 2021 Committee of the Whole meeting to allow the Beaverton Harbour Advisory Committee time for consider” in regard to Communication No. 644/21 – Interoffice Memorandum – Beaverton Skywoman Project.

At the June 2, 2021 BHAC Meeting the following motion was adopted for Council consideration of a sculpture for the Beaverton Harbour.

“The Beaverton Harbour Advisory Committee recommends that Brock Council move forward and approve the gift of a freestanding stainless steel kinetic sculpture for the Beaverton Harbour area, and that Council carefully consider the following points while finalizing and approving the offered public art sculpture:

- Public art is a value add for our communities and the proposed piece by an Internationally acclaimed artist who resides in Brock Township should be viewed as a terrific opportunity for Brock.
- The sculpture should be a key component of an improvement plan for the harbour that compliments and integrates well with current and potential harbour area leisure and boating amenities and activities.
- It is recommended that the sculpture be located in the best available area that produces sightlines from both the land and Lake Simcoe. Interim and final location may be required.
- All financial implications for the Township such as site preparation, sculpture installation and ongoing care and maintenance should be clarified at the outset within a doable budget that works for all stakeholders.
- Final approval of the sculpture design and final location to be approved by Council.”

It is also important to note that Ron Baird has advised that should the gift a sculpture be accepted by Council, that the statue will be a new design and not the originally proposed Skywoman design.
