The day will start with a children's cane pole fishing at the pier and a pancake breakfast. **We would like to use the ice surface in the Foster Hewitt Memorial Community Centre to host the breakfast.** We will bring our tables and chairs Friday at your convenience. **Please provide garbage cans and garbage bags.**

Parade: The parade will start at the Beaverton Fairgrounds on Main St. flow through to Bay St., north on Osborne St., and west on Simcoe St., and back to the Beaverton Fairgrounds. **We ask that the Township please provide the barriers for road closures.** For further information regarding the parade please contact **Chuck Gillespie** [REDACTED] or [REDACTED].

Finally, the club will require use of the fairgrounds for fireworks through Victory Fireworks. The evening events will start at 6 pm with a barbeque, live entertainment, and children's activities. The evening will close out with fireworks at dusk.
