June 10 will be the main "Small Town Big Pride" event held in Port Perry, but we want to include all of North Durham which means we will be rotating small events throughout the different communities leading up to the next big pride event in June the following year. We have partnered with many local businesses throughout the area as well as Durham Region and Durham Tourism. It is our hope that we can also drive visitors and tourism to this area that we have all chosen to live in, work, develop businesses and raise families.
